Cast Care

Drying:

• A new cast 48 hours to dry.

You can help yourself by:

- putting the cast on a pillow or in sling to reduce swelling
- moving your fingers or toes (where the cast is) every hour
- not scratching under the cast
- not getting the cast wet
- calling your doctor or this centre if you have concerns
- **★** Do not walk on a leg cast unless you have been told that you can.
- You may not be allowed to drive with your cast.
 Talk to your doctor about driving. Contact your insurance company to check your coverage.

Watch for signs that the cast is too tight:

- increased pain that is not relieved by prescribed pain control medications
- swelling
- cold, numbness or tingling in fingers or toes (where the cast is)
- change in colour of fingers or toes from your normal colour

Return to this centre right away if the cast becomes tight.
