5.3 REPORT OF PRESIDENTS	 D. Higgins provided an update on two recent cases related to pathology results which were reported in the media. Recommendations on the investigations into these two incidents will be brought forward to the Quality Committee in January.
5.4 REPORT OF PRESIDENTS SJHH FOUNDATION	 D. Higgins gave an update on Ebola preparedness. The majority of staff in the ER and Urgent Care have received Ebola preparedness training. A plan for the training of DI staff is currently underway. It was noted that the Ministry of Labour will visit SJHH with respect to its readiness for Ebola cases in early December. The Chief Medical Officer of Health for the Province is leading a Provincial Steering Committee to coordinate Ebola preparedness efforts and the OHA is coordinating a central supply inventory of Ebola supplies. In response to a question, it was noted that some Ebola supplies can be used to treat other illnesses. It was noted that the response rate for the staff and physician engagement surveys is the same as the last employee engagement survey. The Anti-Stigma Strategy has been launched at all SJHH Campuses. Planning for the October 2015 Anti-Stigma Conference has begun. \$370K was raised for vital medical equipment, research and patient care. The live auction was very successful and raised \$72K for 3 new incubators in the Special Care Nursery. A \$1M gift has been received from Ken and Rachel Flood for the Surgical Program. A \$25K gift has been received from Toyota Canada. The Holiday Appeal has been launched and is an equipment appeal.
	 The Cup of Joe and Partner Restaurant initiatives have been launched. The Around the Bay Road Race will be held on March 29th.

Presentations and Reports to the JBG - Summary

Dr. Mark Crowther, Vice President of Research at St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton provided a presentation on the Research St. Joe's Institute. The update included rationale for formation of this organization, progress to date on establishment of a Board of Directors, an ongoing marketing campaign and upcoming events including HELP (Health Enquiry Learning Panel), Research Day and New Collaborations Grant. Metrics being monitored to evaluate this initiative and immediate benefits being realized were highlighted and discussed.
